The objective of the Marie-Curie International Reintegration Grants (IRG) is to reinforce the attractiveness of Europe by encouraging European researchers who have carried out research outside Europe for at least three years. The scheme aims to reintegrate the researchers to a Member State or an Associated country in order to contribute to European research and transfer the knowledge they have acquired in a third country, by offering them the opportunity to capitalise on their experience in Europe.
