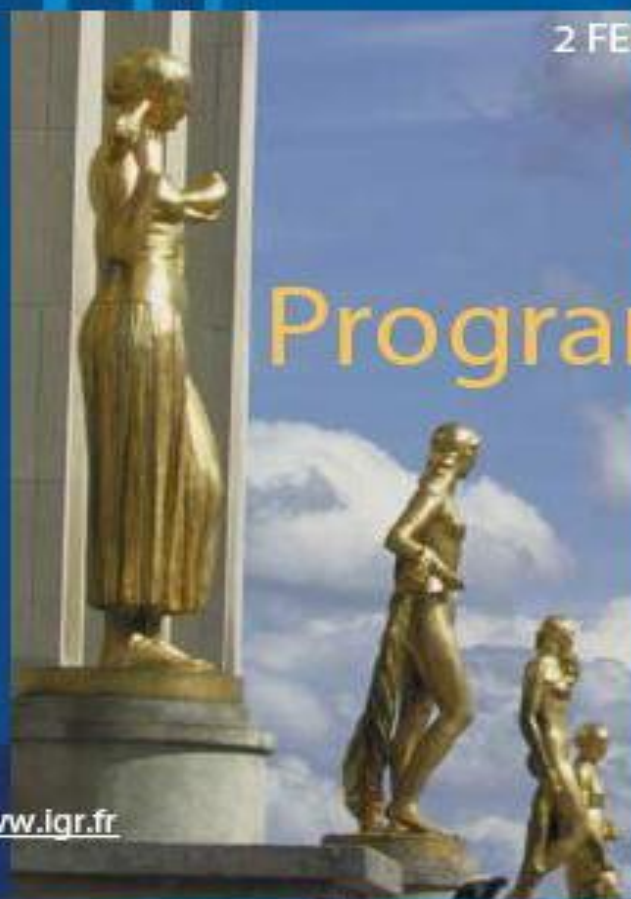

Dear OECI members, Dear Colleagues,

The OECI Accreditation working group is pursuing its project dedicated to the improvement of quality of prevention, care, research, education and the monitoring of comprehensive quality care.

We strongly believe that setting standards in all these areas will allow us improve survival and quality of care for cancer patients.

Our project has started since one year with dedicated resources. We've respected the project plan approved by OECI members during the General Assembly held in Berlin in May 2005. We presented the progress of our work during our last general assembly in Izmir in May 2006, and the General Assembly brought again its full support to the OECI Accreditation project.

As you already know, our objectives are to set standards and criteria for quality multidisciplinary cancer care delivered in cancer centres throughout Europe, to survey the cancer centres to assess compliance with those standards, to collect standardised and quality data from approved cancer centres, to measure treatments patterns and outcomes. We aim at using the data to evaluate cancer centre provider performance and develop effective systems and interventions that will allow us to improve cancer care outcomes at the national and European level.

As already announced during the general assembly in Izmir in May, we have organised our first OECI Accreditation workshop today in Villejuif and wish to thank you for attending this very important meeting where we will make the first presentation of the OECI accreditation tool and present the results of the first pilot that took place in several OECI voluntary cancer institutes in Europe.

The core of our project is the OECI Accreditation tool which is currently in its pilot phase. We need to discuss the results of this first pilot with you in order to adapt our tool to your expectations and needs.


We also need to share views with you on the second pilot that will take place in several other cancer centres throughout Europe. This second pilot will not only allow us to test the new version of the OECI electronic accreditation tool but also to test the peer review system where auditors will visit the participating centres in order to perform an external evaluation.

As you will see on the agenda, we have also invited our European partners who are already working on quality programmes in their respective areas of interest. Their presentations will allow us to better discuss ways of synergic interactions with those organisations.

Of course we will organise and provide those who will be willing to act as auditors with a few days of training sessions on auditing and peer reviewing. This will be provided by professional audit training organisations that we are currently selecting and appointing.

All the members of the Accreditation working group and our local host, Professor Thomas Tursz, are pleased to welcome you in Villejuif on 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2007. We plan a nice social programme after this long working day.
